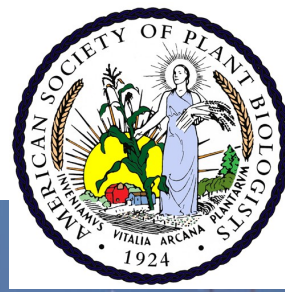


## **Western Regional Meeting of ASPB - Come meet the neighbors at Washington State University!**
